

What is SASMI?


- Began in May 2021 as a collaborative effort between the Southeast Regional Partnership for Planning and Sustainability (SERPPAS) and the Pew Charitable Trusts
- Regional North Carolina through east-central Florida
- Partners from local, state, and federal Agencies; NGOs; academics; military; community leaders
- Voluntary, non-regulatory partnership





Goal: To enhance the long-term abundance, health and resilience of the approximately 1 million acres of salt marshes within the South Atlantic states to ensure no overall loss of the benefits these wetlands provide to fish, wildlife and people.

Conserve marsh 2. migration corridors and remove or retrofit barriers to ensure salt marshes can shift as sea levels rise.


